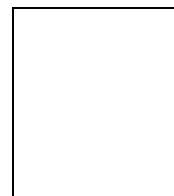

The Event

Marathon (including Devon County Championships)

An undulating 26.2 mile two-lap run in the shadow of Dartmoor. To qualify to enter the Devon County Championships, you must be a member of an affiliated club, must live or have been born in Devon and must not have competed in any other County Championships in 2010. There is no additional entry fee.

Half Marathon

An undulating 13.1 mile run in the shadow of Dartmoor.

10K Road Race

A fairly level 10k run around Kingsteignton.

Charity

This is a fund-raising event, with all the surplus going to charity. In seven years, we have helped raise over £75,000 for charity. This year, any Charity that registers with us will receive any sponsorship you raise, plus Gift Aid plus a share of the overall surplus. So please ask your favourite charity to contact us.

Courses

The courses are between Kingsteignton (near Newton Abbot) and Chudleigh, in the shadow of Dartmoor. They are entirely on tarmac, with the start and finish at Sibelco, East Gold Works, Newton Road, Newton Abbot. New routes are being designed to increase the mileage in the countryside and reduce that in Kingsteignton. The races will be controlled by marshals, with drinks, first aid stations, distance markers and time clocks. The courses are suitable for wheelchair users. Unofficial cyclists will not be permitted to accompany runners. All dogs and wheeled carriages other than wheelchairs are banned. We regret that we are unable to provide changing or shower facilities.

Organisers

This event is being organised by The Rotary Club of Dartmoor Vale. Road Race Permits are being obtained from U K Athletics. The courses will be formally measured and certified accurate.

Prizes and Trophies

Prizes/trophies will be awarded to the first 3 men and first 3 ladies in the Marathon, the first 5 men and first 5 ladies in the Half Marathon and 10k. Prizes will also be awarded in the age categories M40, M45, M50 M55, M60 and M70, F35, F40, F45, F50, F55 and F60 dependent upon the numbers of runners in each category. Trophies are also awarded separately for the Devon County Championships. All finishers will receive a medal and memento.

Entries and Entry Fees

Entry fees are shown in the relevant part of the entry form.

Closing date of postal entries is 8 October 2010 or earlier when maximum numbers are reached. There will be a maximum entry limit for all races. In 2009, the Half Marathon and 10k races were fully subscribed.

Joining instructions will be sent out in September.

Time Limits

There will be a 5 hour time limit for the Marathon and Half Marathon and 2 hours for the 10K Road Race.
